



## 2012 HRYRA Junior Qualifier Regatta

### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012* (RRS), the US Sailing Prescriptions (Prescriptions) and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Changes to the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, if any, will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 Races will be started in accordance with Rule 26. (5 minute sequence; sounds at 5, 4, 1, start.)

#### 2. QUALIFYING EVENT

- 2.1 The top two eligible HRYRA teams from each fleet will be offered the opportunity to represent HRYRA at the Area B US Sailing Semi-Finals for the Bemis and Smythe trophies hosted by Mason Island Yacht Club on July 24 & 25 (NOR attached).
- 2.2 The top five eligible HRYRA Club 420 teams will be offered the opportunity to represent HRYRA at the Junior Challenge regatta at SUNY Maritime on or about July 31st.
- 2.3 If one of the qualifying teams is not able to, or interested in, representing HRYRA, the next highest placed team will be offered the opportunity.

#### 3. FLEETS

- 3.1 A minimum of three (3) boats is required to register, or the fleet will not be sailed.
  - 3.1.1 Singlehanded Dinghy Fleet BYOB Laser Radial
  - 3.1.2 Doublehanded Dinghy Fleet BYOB Club 420 with Spinnaker, Trapeze, and mainsheet bridle
- 3.2 A limited number of 420's may be available from the host club. Please contact Peter Feroe at [pferoe@gmail.com](mailto:pferoe@gmail.com) as soon as possible to request a boat, if needed.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 4.1 Competitors are encouraged to pre-register using the [on-line registration form](#) and bring the registration fee to the regatta.
- 4.2 Registrations WILL be accepted up to 1000 hrs on July 7, 2012
- 4.3 Registration fee is \$5 per competitor.
- 4.4 Participants must turn 13 but may not turn 19 in the year 2012. In order to compete in the Area B US Sailing Semi-finals, competitors must meet all requirements of the US Sailing Championship Events.

#### 5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS for Saturday July 7, 2012

0900 - 1000 hrs	Registration & check-in, SYC clubhouse deck
1000 hrs	Competitor's Meeting, SYC clubhouse deck
1100 hrs	First race

6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** – The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. **SCORING** – One race shall be completed to constitute a series.

8. **SAFETY** – A US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device shall be worn, properly fastened, at all times while launching and when sailing, except for brief times when changing clothing.

#### 9. FOOD AND WATER

- 9.1 Water will be available to competitors from the Race Committee while on the water.
- 9.2 Competitors should provide their own lunch, which the Race Committee will store on board. Competitors should be prepared to eat on the water. This will be discussed at the Competitor's meeting.

10. **POOL & CLUBHOUSE** – Competitors, their families, and coaches are explicitly welcome to use the club's pool and clubhouse as guests during the day.
