**** NOTICE OF RACE ****

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions modify rule 28 (see CSI 6.2), rule 26 (see CSI 8.1 and 8.2), a US Sailing Prescription (see CSI 15.2), rule 44.3 (see CSI 16.2), rule 34, A4, and A5 (see CSI 17.2), rule 60.1(a) (see CSI 18.2), rule A4.2 (see CSI 20.1), and rule A2 (see CSI 20.2 and 20.3).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all cruising classes that have a PHRF rating issued by HRYRA or YRALIS.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the attached Registration Form together with the required fee by 1000, September 12, 2009, to the indicated address.
- 2.3. Late registrations may be accepted on the water at the discretion of the Race Committee.

3. FEES

- 3.1. \$25 for USSailing Members, \$30 others. Additional \$5 if registering after September 5.
- 3.2. Fees for the associated dinner on September 12 are \$40 per adult. See the Flyer for the Shattemuc Annual Pig Roast, appended hereto, for details and registration.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Register by mail prior to September 5, or at the club on September 12.
- 4.2. Two (2) Races are schedule for Saturday, first gun at 1100; and two (2) races for Sunday, first gun at 1030.

5. MEASUREMENTS

- 5.1. Each boat shall produce a currently valid PHRF certificate issued by HRYRA or by YRALIS.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. The sailing instructions will be available before September 5 on the Shattemuc Web Site: www.shattemucyc.org/racing.htm, and on the HRYRA web site: www.hryra.org.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The racing area will be the waters of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton Point.
- 7.2. The starting area will be in the Hudson River south of Croton Point.
- 7.3. Courses are listed in the Sailing Instructions.

8. BERTHING

- 8.1. A limited amount of space is available in the marina or on moorings, on a first come, first served basis. Good anchoring is available off the north end of the Club.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 9.1. Racers shall monitor VHF channel 72 for communications from the Race Committee.
- 9.2. Except in an emergency or notification to the Race Committee, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first in each class having at least 3 starters, second in each class having at least 6 starters, and third in each class having at least 9 starters.

11. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

- 11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. Shattemuc Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
