** NOTICE OF RACE **

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Sailing Instructions incorporate the HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions, available at <http://www.hryra.org/content/hryra-common-sailing-instructions> which modify several Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.3. The Sailing Instructions modify Rule 4.3 of the Common Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all cruising classes that have a PHRF rating issued by HRYRA or YRALIS. There will be 3 classes as indicated on the registration form.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the attached Registration Form together with the required fee by 1000, September 10, 2011, to the indicated address.
- 2.3. Late registrations may be accepted on the water at the discretion of the Race Committee.

3. FEES

- 3.1. \$30 for USSailing Members, \$35 others. Additional \$5 if registering after September 4.
- 3.2. Fees for the associated dinner on Saturday, September 10 are separate and additional – please see the Flyer for the Shattemuc Annual Regatta dinner for details and reservations.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Register by mail (must be received by September 3) or at the club on September 10.
- 4.2. Two (2) Races are scheduled for Saturday, first gun at 1100; and two (2) races for Sunday, first gun at 1030.
- 4.3. For each class, the second race each day will be started as soon as practical after the last finisher of the class's previous race. Three sound signals will be made approximately 5 minutes before the race's warning signal.

5. MEASUREMENTS

- 5.1. Each boat shall have a currently valid PHRF certificate issued by HRYRA or by YRALIS.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. The sailing instructions will be available by September 4 on the Shattemuc web site: <http://www.shattemucyc.org/activities/racing>, and on the HRYRA web site: www.hryra.org.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The racing area will be the waters of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton Point.
- 7.2. The starting area will be on the Hudson River south of Croton Point.
- 7.3. Courses are listed in the Sailing Instructions.

8. BERTHING

- 8.1. A limited number of berths are available in the marina or on moorings. Please contact the dock master (914-941-8777 Ext. 74 or 75) for assignment prior to use. Good anchoring is available off the north end of the Club.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 9.1. Racers shall monitor VHF channel 72 for communications from the Race Committee.
- 9.2. Except in an emergency or notification to the Race Committee, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions while racing that are not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10. SCORING & PRIZES

- 10.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs.
- 10.2. Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first, second, and third in each class having at least 3, 6, and 9 starters, respectively.

11. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

- 11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk: See rule 4, Decision to Race. Shattemuc Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
