125th Annual Open HRYRA Regatta

Saturday & Sunday September 12 & 13, 2009

Instructions HRYRA 2009 (.2) Common Sailing Instructions except as modified below.

Management The regatta shall be managed by the Race Committee of the Shattemuc Yacht Club.

Entries Official registration closes at 10:00 EDT on Saturday of the Regatta. Participants attempting to register after this time will be scored at the discretion of the race committee.

Notices Notices will be posted on the bulletin board located south of the clubhouse.

Changes Changes to these Sailing Instructions will be posted at least 1 hour prior to the first Scheduled Warning Signal on the day they are to take effect, except that any change in the initial schedule of races for a day will be posted by 2100 of the day before it takes effect.

Classes There will be Cruising Classes 1, 2, and 3 as defined in Instr. 5 of the HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions.

Order of Starts As defined in Instr. 4.2 of the HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions.

First Gun 1100

Subsequent Starts A class's race may be started as soon as practical following the last finisher in that class's previous race.
No race will be started after 15:30.

Sunday

First Gun 1030

Subsequent Starts A class's race may be started as soon as practical following the last finisher in that class's previous race.

Awards As soon as possible following the finish of last race and any protest hearings.

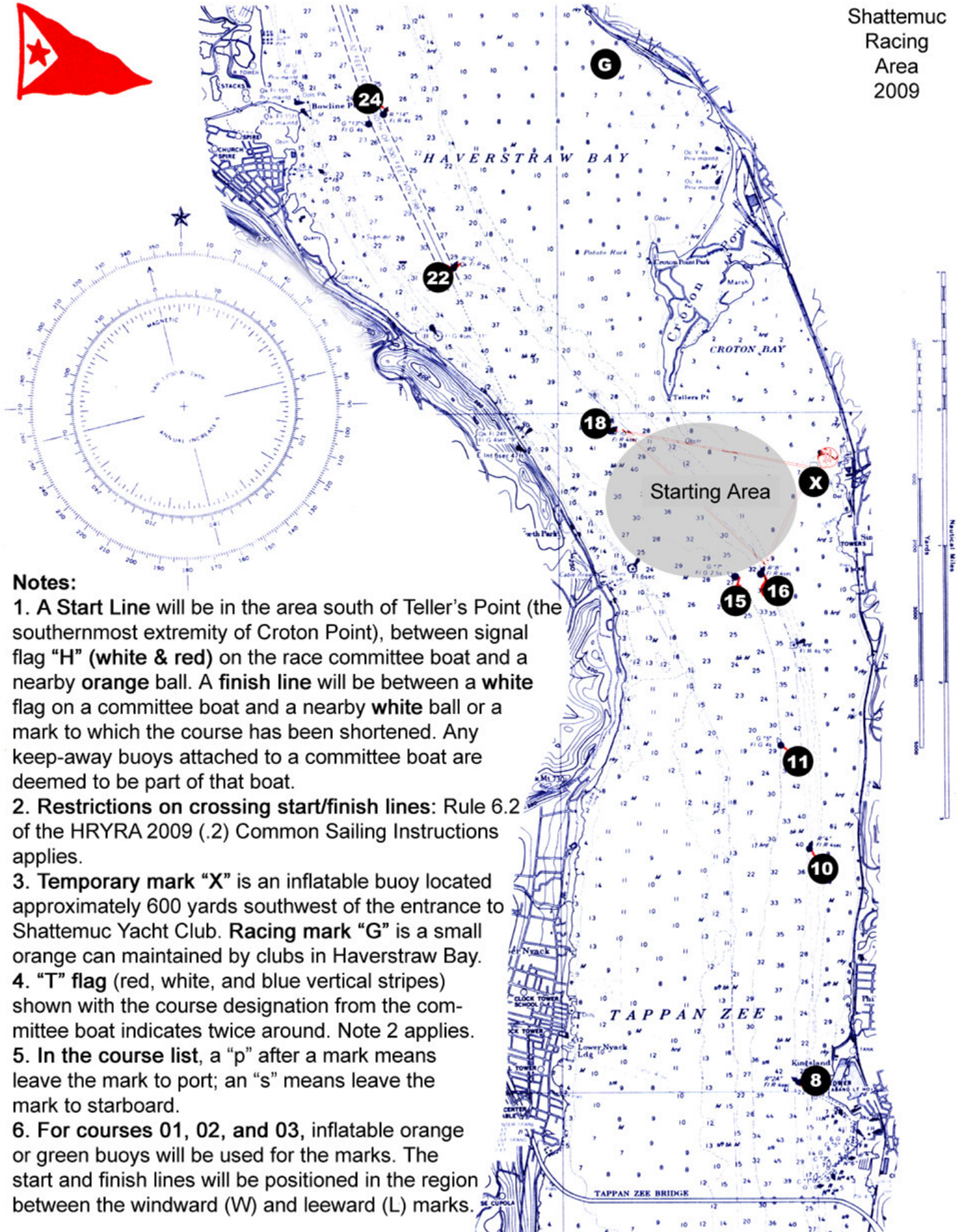
- Race Area** The racing area is shown on the attached chart. Start/finish lines, marks, etc., are described in notes on that chart.
- Courses** Courses are selected from those listed on a sheet “120 Annual Shattemuc Regatta Courses”. The course for a race will be announced by displaying its number from the Committee Boat.
- Protests** A written protest must be filed within ½ hour after the Committee Boat’s return to the dock at the end of the racing day. Protest meetings will be held as soon as possible after the race.
- Awards** Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first in each class provided there are 3 or more starters, second if 6 or more starters, and third if 9 or more starters. All awards not affected by undecided protests will be presented at the Shattemuc Clubhouse after racing on Sunday of the Regatta, and all results are tabulated.
- Safety** Each yacht must comply with current HRYRA safety equipment recommendations
- VHF Radios** Each yacht shall monitor VHF channel 72 for race committee notifications. A yacht retiring shall notify the Race Committee on Channel 72. No general inquiries will be entertained.
- Responsibility** In accordance to Part 1 of the Racing Rules of Sailing Fundamental Rules of Sailing.

Notes:

1. A Start Line will be in the area south of Teller's Point (the southernmost extremity of Croton Point), between signal flag "H" (white & red) on the race committee boat and a nearby orange ball. A finish line will be between a white flag on a committee boat and a nearby white ball or a mark to which the course has been shortened. Any keep-away buoys attached to a committee boat are deemed to be part of that boat.
2. Restrictions on crossing start/finish lines: Rule 6.2 of the HRYRA 2009 (.2) Common Sailing Instructions applies.
3. Temporary mark "X" is an inflatable buoy located approximately 600 yards southwest of the entrance to Shattemuc Yacht Club. Racing mark "G" is a small orange can maintained by clubs in Haverstraw Bay.
4. "T" flag (red, white, and blue vertical stripes) shown with the course designation from the committee boat indicates twice around. Note 2 applies.
5. In the course list, a "p" after a mark means leave the mark to port; an "s" means leave the mark to starboard.
6. For courses 01, 02, and 03, inflatable orange or green buoys will be used for the marks. The start and finish lines will be positioned in the region between the windward (W) and leeward (L) marks.
