NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The equipment and measurement rules of the class associations of all boats entered.
- 1.3 Changes to the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, if any, will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

2. QUALIFYING AND SERIES EVENT

- 2.1 The top THREE (3) 420 teams will qualify to represent HRYRA and the Junior Challenge Regatta at SUNY Maritime.
- 2.2 The 420 Class scores will count toward the HRYRA Junior Championship Series.

3. FLEETS

- 3.1 One Design Dinghy—ALL AGES— Any one-design dinghy may enter. A minimum of three (3) boats are required to for a separate class start. Likely classes include.
 - 3.1.1 Sunfish
 - 3.1.2 Club 420 (with mainsheet bridle, spinnaker, and trapeze)
 - 3.1.3 Opti
 - 3.1.4 O'Pen Bic
 - 3.1.5 Laser

4. ENTRY

- 4.1 Registration fee is \$10 per boat (payable at check-in).
- 4.2 Registration will be taken during the morning of the event.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS for July 19, 2014

- 6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** – The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

- 7. **SCORING** - One race shall be completed to constitute a series.

- 8. **SAFETY** – A US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device shall be worn, properly fastened, at all times while launching and when sailing, except for brief times when changing clothing.

- 9. **POOL & CLUBHOUSE** – Competitors, their families, and coaches are explicitly welcome to use the club's pool and clubhouse as guests during the day.
