

# Sailing Instructions

Shattemuc Yacht Club

124th Annual Open HRYRA Regatta

Saturday & Sunday September 6 & 7, 2008

**Instructions** HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions except as modified below.

**Management** The regatta shall be managed by the Race Committee of the Shattemuc Yacht Club.

**Entries** Official registration closes at 10:45 EDT Saturday September 6, 2008. Participants attempting to register after this time will be scored at the discretion of the race committee.

**Notices** Notices will be posted on the bulletin board located south of the clubhouse

**Changes** Changes to these Sailing Instructions will be posted at least 1 hour prior to the first Scheduled Warning Signal on the day it will take effect, except that any change in the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 of the day before it takes place.

**Classes** There will be Cruising Classes A, B, and C as defined in the Common Sailing Instructions.

**Order of Starts** The scheduled order of starts is A, B, C as defined in sec. 9 of the Common Instructions.

## **Schedule Saturday**

Registration 0900 -1000 SYC Clubhouse

First Gun 1100

Second Start Approximately ½ hour after last finisher in first race

No race will be started after 15:30.

## **Sunday**

First Gun 1030

Second Start: Approximately ½ hour after last finisher in first race

Awards Following finish of last race

**Race Area** The racing area is shown on the attached sheet

**Courses** Start/Finish lines and courses are listed on a separate sheet "120 Annual Shattemuc Regatta Courses".

**Protests** A written protest must be filed within ½ hour after the Committee Boat's return to the dock at the end of the racing day. Protest meetings will be held as soon as possible after the race.

**Awards** Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first in each class provided there are 3 or more starters, second if 6 or more starters, and third if 9 or more starters. All awards not affected by protest will be presented at the Shattemuc Clubhouse after racing on Sunday September 10, and all results are tabulated.

**Safety** Each yacht must comply with current HRYRA safety equipment recommendations

**VHF Radios** Each yacht shall monitor VHF channel 72 for race committee notifications. A yacht retiring shall notify the Race Committee on Channel 72. No general inquiries will be entertained.

**Responsibility** In accordance to Part 1 of the Racing Rules of Sailing Fundamental Rules of Sailing.

**Committee Boat "Keep Away Buoys"** One or more "keep away" buoys (floating balls or fenders) may be employed near the Committee Boat.

If used, the keep away buoys will be located in the immediate vicinity of the race committee boat and should be considered an extension of the committee boat itself. A yacht may **not** enter the area between the keep away buoys and the race committee boat at any time. Yachts entering this area will be subject to the same penalty(s) as though they had collided with the committee boat itself. If more than one yacht is involved a protest committee hearing will be held to determine which yacht(s) will be penalized.

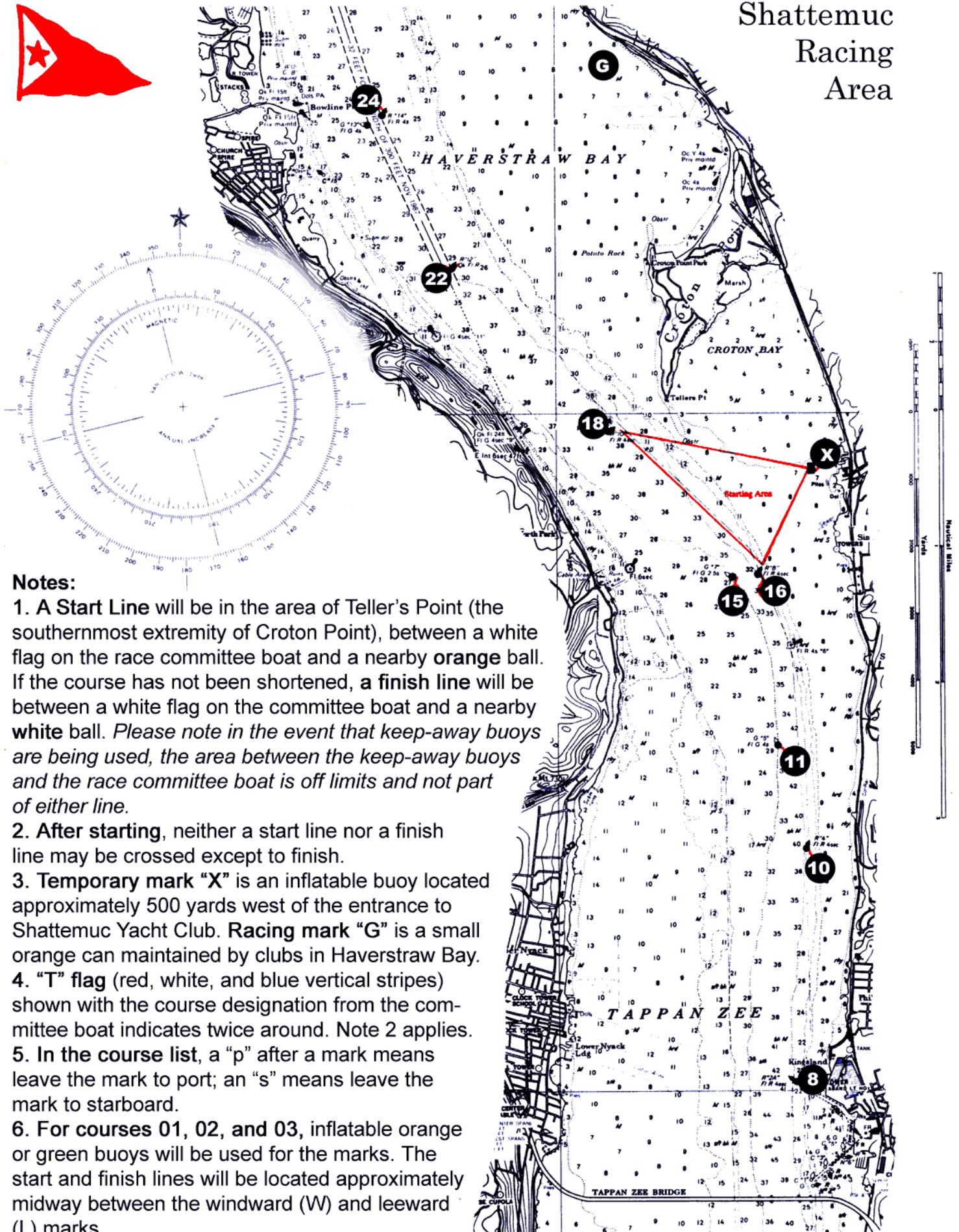

## Notes:

1. A Start Line will be in the area of Tellers Point (the southern most extremity of Croton Point), between a white flag on the race committee boat and a nearby orange ball; If the course has not been shortened, a finish line will be between a white flag on the committee boat and a nearby white ball or floating mark. *Please note in the event that keep away buoys are being used, the area between the keep away buoy and the race committee boat is off limits and not part of the start line.*
2. After starting, neither a start line nor a finish line may be crossed except to finish.
3. Temporary mark "X" is an inflatable buoy, located approximately 500 yards west of the entrance to Shattemuc Yacht Club.
4. "T" flag (red, white, blue vertical stripes) flying from race committee boat indicates the course should be sailed twice around. **Note 2 applies.**
5. In the course list, a "p" after a mark means leave the mark to port, an "s" after a mark means leave the mark to starboard.
6. For courses 01, 02, and 03 inflatable orange or green buoys will be used for the marks. The start finish line will be located approximately midway between the windward (W) and leeward (L) marks.
7. Racing mark "G" is a small orange can that is maintained by clubs that race in the Haverstraw Bay area.

## Notes:

1. A Start Line will be in the area of Teller's Point (the southernmost extremity of Croton Point), between a white flag on the race committee boat and a nearby orange ball. If the course has not been shortened, a finish line will be between a white flag on the committee boat and a nearby white ball. Please note in the event that keep-away buoys are being used, the area between the keep-away buoys and the race committee boat is off limits and not part of either line.
2. After starting, neither a start line nor a finish line may be crossed except to finish.
3. Temporary mark "X" is an inflatable buoy located approximately 500 yards west of the entrance to Shattemuc Yacht Club. Racing mark "G" is a small orange can maintained by clubs in Haverstraw Bay.
4. "T" flag (red, white, and blue vertical stripes) shown with the course designation from the committee boat indicates twice around. Note 2 applies.
5. In the course list, a "p" after a mark means leave the mark to port; an "s" means leave the mark to starboard.
6. For courses 01, 02, and 03, inflatable orange or green buoys will be used for the marks. The start and finish lines will be located approximately midway between the windward (W) and leeward (L) marks.
7. Racing mark "G" is a small orange can that is maintained by clubs that race in the Haverstraw Bay area.
